An elegant ewer or wine decanter featuring a spherical body made of clear crystal, finely engraved with a wheel-engraved design of vine branches, leaves, and grape clusters. It features a rich silver-plated metal mount in the Louis XV style, adorned with shells, acanthus leaves, fluting, and rocaille motifs. The flared neck is topped by a hinged lid with a foliage design. The large openwork handle, formed of volutes, harmoniously extends the decoration of the mount. The piece rests on a scalloped and molded base, lavishly engraved with plant motifs. A circular hallmark on the mount indicates that it is made of silver-plated metal. Height: 29 cm
