Description

A pair of gilded bronze candlesticks, finely engraved with flowers and branches, signed by Alfred Daubrée. Each candlestick features a baluster-shaped shaft, richly adorned with plant motifs, resting on a beveled base decorated with an elegant foliage frieze. The chiseling and the delicacy of the decoration attest to the care taken in crafting this pair of candlesticks, characteristic of decorative art from the second half of the 19th century. Alfred Daubrée was a sculptor born in Nancy and who died in Paris. He worked as a goldsmith in Nancy, then as a dealer in art bronzes and jewelry in Montmartre, Paris. He was cited as a remarkable foundryman at the 1867 Paris World's Fair. Period: Napoleon III, second half of the 19th century, circa 1854-1885. Height: 14.5 cm.
