This elegant set, made around 1900, is made of glazed earthenware of the barbotine/majolica type. It consists of two vases with stylized double handles and an oval-shaped planter or centerpiece. The set features a delicate floral design depicting anemone flowers in shades of white and pink, accompanied by foliage, on a nuanced green background. The naturalistic design and the shapes of the pieces are characteristic of the Art Nouveau aesthetic, inspired by the plant world. This set was manufactured in France by the Faïencerie Gustave De Bruyn, based in Fives-Lille, a factory renowned for its earthenware productions and Art Nouveau-style creations.
