Description

Description :An elegant English Victorian display cabinet dating to circa 1880, crafted in mahogany and distinguished by its unusual pair of large oval glass-panelled doors. The cabinet has beautifully balanced proportions, with a gently shaped façade, moulded top and curved plinth base creating a particularly graceful silhouette. The two doors are framed by fine mouldings and open to reveal a spacious interior fitted with shaped wooden shelves. Their distinctive oval glass panels provide an excellent view of the interior, making the cabinet ideal for displaying porcelain, glassware, silver, books or a collection of decorative objects. Particularly attractive are the carved details positioned beneath the projecting upper corners, featuring scrolling foliage and floral motifs characteristic of Victorian decorative

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furniture. The warm tones of the mahogany and its pronounced grain complement the sculptural quality of the cabinet and have developed an appealing patina over time. The cabinet remains in good antique condition, with minor marks and variations consistent with its age and use. The top presents a few small, shallow surface undulations, discreet within the overall appearance and primarily noticeable upon close inspection. A highly decorative yet practical example of late 19th-century English furniture, combining generous display space with relatively compact proportions.
