Stunning Louis XV-era chiffonnière chest of drawers with fine marquetry. Stamped "Léonard Boudin" (1745-1804). The stamp is visible beneath the marble top. Léonard Boudin, a renowned Parisian cabinetmaker, was granted master status in 1761. 18th-century Parisian craftsmanship. It is topped with a superb original incarnat marble (veined red) top, with a double bevel, intact, and 4 cm thick. It features 4 drawers on the front. A key is included and works for all drawers. Decorated with floral motifs on each drawer; the side panels feature light, flowing lines. Precious wood marquetry veneer with floral and foliage motifs on a curly-grain background. It rests on a slightly arched base. Perfect stability. Richly ornamented with finely chiseled gilded bronze on the lock plates, spindles, and
