An elegant vase made of glazed artistic stoneware, with a slender baluster shape and a cylindrical neck. The surface is enlivened by a beautiful flamed and iridescent glaze, blending shades of deep blue, turquoise, green, and brown, with subtle metallic highlights. The variations in the firing process give the piece a particularly decorative depth and richness. This piece is characteristic of Gilbert Méténier's work in Gannat, famous for its stoneware with flamed glazes and, in particular, for its bluish tones, sometimes referred to as "Gannat blue." The base bears the signature of Gilbert Méténier and the inscription "Gannat." Height 29.5 cm, diameter 10.5 cm, in perfect condition. Carefully and securely packaged.
