Japanese sculpted group of the Edo period, charming and expressive, contained four children and a dog having fun. The object is carved in the mass, in one piece. 3 children are perched on a tree trunk, the fourth is standing at the foot of the tree, the dog at his side. The child's highest hilltop is holding a fan, and at the lower level, another holds a kind of clipboard. The costumes of 4 characters are delicately carved small varied patterns, inked sepia tone. Children's hair are carved and colored. All these characters are very cleverly and intricately carved, significantly better than the netsuke although they come close by their size. This is why we can speak of mastery of the sculptor. This sculpture group is in very good condition, including all the characters and animals have their heads and mouths, hands,
