In a setting of architectural whim, the milieu of ruins under a Janus representative surrounded tondo of the zodiac signs, a young Bacchus crowned with vine branches washing a bunch of grapes in a cut.

at his feet a putto asleep.

the features of these children are charming, colors remained very cool.

the coat of arms with Janus brings an esoteric side to this work of mythological influence.
