Description

Norman cross pendant in gold adorned with rhinestones. It is time 1st Empire, as well as evidenced by the punches applied to the two parts constituting the book: Punch the cock head turned to the left, used from 1809 to 1819 for 18K The cross is therefore consists of two parts, a movable part connected to the upper part by a large ring winding. The grounds are made of perforated scrolls drawing a very scalloped edge. On this fishnet arabesque applied hammered cones 5, the largest at the cross arm. A small rosette rhinestone faceted adorns this central cone, as well as that of the mobile part. Other stones laid in rows or single, complete the ornamentation. The jewel is in very good condition. The end of the bottom left, bordering the cone to his left, was formerly stuck together, and this work of
