Rare and beautiful hairdresser man veneer citron and amaranth of style Louis XVI and XVIII time. It rests on four tube legs ending in casters, opens in front with three drawers and is topped with a tray opening and sliding with a mirror inside. The interior plateau of the dressing consists of a blue marble turquin. The elegy panels and drawer fronts are ornamented round quarterfinals brass. This dressing is a high quality of execution, with its wood used and its tray with sliding mechanism. In very good condition, light accidents plating.
