### Description

A Louis XIV style cabinet in light oak, originating from the Île-de-France region. The lower section has two doors on the front, concealing two drawers (originally used for storing silverware) and a shelf. The upper section has two doors on the front and three shelves inside, each with a sliding mechanism. The interior of the upper section is finished in waxed wood. The cabinet is held together with lag bolts, a construction method typical of this region.
