In the center of the door surrounded by lush vegetation is a divinity seated on the head of an elephant can be is a question there of Indra on his white elephant. Exceptional quality and great finesse this work is done in shades of white and gray color on a paper background beige. Trace bottom left signature. rosewood frame bordered by a small molding ogee inside and encrusted with three threads of light wood Dimensions: 72.4 cm x 54.6 frame cm for 47.5 cm x 35.5 cm. Time, late nineteenth century.
