Entirely hand-knotted, Vegetable dyes, Pure wool, Size: 2,32mX1,52m The name "Turkmen carpet" means the carpets made in various regions, including Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, East Turkestan, Afghanistan and Baluchistan. Turkmen carpets have, among others, bashir carpet salor, Tekke, and tjaudor Yomut, which are all examples of carpet that were called, until a few decades ago still Bukhara carpets. What distinguishes the Turkmen carpet is, among others, that their chain is almost always wool, their motives like "göl" are repetitive, and they often have wide borders on the widths that are not found on the lengths. Red, playing on the whole range from purple to brown is a dominant color.
