Drawing in pencil on blue paper with a small touch of white chalk signed on the right A. BRUNE. Adolphe BRUNE (born in Paris in 1802 - died 1875). Pupil of the Beaux Arts from 1824, medalist in 1834, 1838, 1848. Three paintings are owed to him in the hall of the Senate Palace, the ceiling of the new library of the Louvre, painting of the chapel Ste Catherine de l The church of St Roch and the portraits of Louis XII, Charles IX in the galleries of Versailles. It exhibits "original sin" in the salon of 1870. Present in many museums: Versailles, Cahors, Avignon, Tours, Troyes ... but rare on the market. Original frame 43 x 53 cm Two small tasks on the bottom.
