French work, era Charles X Superb pair of chairs in rosewood stamped by the master cabinetmaker "MARCUS". MARCUS, a carpenter in furniture, was a manufacturer and store of chairs, armchairs and seats of all kinds, made of indigenous and foreign wood. Established 36 rue Amelot between 1827-1842; But already under the Consulate and the Empire, he had invented a sofa with backrests and arched cheeks that bore his name. Entirely retapissé in the rules of the art, upholster from father to son since 1880.
