The game made: 67 x 64 cm Around 1810 Each of the 64 boxes represents a different animal made in pencil and then finalized in ink for the most part. All the boxes are numbered and titled in ink of the name of the animal and below the drawing a text written in ink describes the latter. The author is not satisfied with some drawings, he has erased the animals in 10 squares, one can still guess them. Many African and exotic animals Some boxes are signed: Made by MOTET This is a project not completely completed. A box has an error. Entitled: La Civette, it actually presents rabbits, the next box also titled The Civet shows this animal well.
