Beautiful composition in autumn colors that mixes game birds with seasonal fruits. Green-glazed sandstone pots respond to the foliage and feathers of the neck. Arthur Brunel de Neuville (Paris, 1852-1941) "He is the painter of the fruits, he exalts in his still lifes the velvety, the silky and silky preciosity by opposing them to the dry matter of the wicker baskets. He exhibited at the Salon des artistes français from 1879 small paintings featuring games of cats and kittens, a genre then highly prized by amateurs. The painter is represented in several provincial museums, notably in Béziers, Brest, and Louviers "(Cabanne-Schurr dictionary of the small master of painting.) He signed his works, besides his name of different pseudos such as" Leroux "
