



Astonishing Cigar Box XIXe Ingenuous Secrets



Description

Here is an undoubtedly unique, long-thought and very well realized object, entirely by hand, by its inventor at the end of the 19th century. We took a long time to understand. It is a large barrel of colored wood, in yew and olive, partly inlaid, partly blackened wood. It stands on 3 feet, is closed by a beautiful lid turned in the form of a fountain that contains a housing for matches. To open the lid, turn the hexagonal base of the fountain: an elastic system makes the 3 wooden bolts of the opening retract.

Once opened, you can distinguish, around a cylinder of tin, (humidifier), the housing for 17 cigars, size "diplomat" that one can not reach directly, avoiding to damage or steal .

To make them rise along the shelters, we must find a ring in a foot, the thrust of which will

release the notch of a tube of turned boxwood, (which could contain a thermometer), This tube is pulled, which causes all the cigars to be brought together manually. Look at the photos, it's impressive. Dimensions: 35cm, 19cm diameter Condition: excellent, no flaws, Tel: 0665241111
