Decor of a house-village with characters, many details including some which with kaolin (drying clothes, curtain window ...).

Object of curiosity and creative prowess ceramist, in the spirit of the bubble houses of the 70s and shared habitats of Le Corbusier, or Jacques Rougerie under the influence of Prouvé.
