His most famous work was the design of the magazine launched in 1891 that helped popularize the stories of Arthur Conan Doyle's Sherlock Holmes.In London in the early 1870s he began to make a name for himself as a designer of carpet wallpaper patterns, tapestry and stained glass. In 1883 he exhibited his paintings at the Royal Academy. Desiree performs oils, watercolors and pencils, he specializes in landscapes during his trips to Venice, Morocco and Northern Europe.In 1897 his scene "Dortmund Street" won the first
