Here is a good two-function surgeon tool. Buffalo horn and steel for the handles. The main blade finishes rounded, to preserve the organs during the progression, the sleeves open with a detent of steel and internal spring. This beautiful piece was at the time used for emergency medical analysis, well described and photographed in the book of Dr. Gaboriau: Tools of Health and Medicine, on page 42. Object well signed: A.Perray , Nogent. Dimensions: 34cm x 3,5cm. The condition is good without flaw, no breakage, no lack, we only report slight wear, scratches and stains on the steel, the blade would be better repolished French work, good quality, dating from mid-nineteenth century, around 1840-1860, a beautiful antique object
