He was given the discovery of Etretat where he settled and then he died at Honfleur around 1824, it is during this period that he made this drawing. Quality drawing, where we can see an annimated scene of characters and houses with collages. Signed EI bottom right, this drawing also includes a monogram probably a collection. Contemporary frame.
