Carved coconut, richly decorated with many characters: Roman soldiers fighting as well as women and children fleeing a fortified city and its castle, the Roman camp being installed in the background among a forest, the end decorated with a grotesque face, work of sailor or convict *, XIXth century. This coconut is in very good condition. He misses the sulphure eyes of the face. A report: tiny small shocks and wear of use, see photos. * The Coconut: like the corozo, it was worked by sailors or convicts. The latter worked to pass the time but also and especially to make a little money to improve their lives. Can also be attributed to sailors on their long journeys.
