But who is this Henry Prité? Despite all my research, I have not managed to identify this painter near Pont-Aven and the two pastels that we present give an idea of his talent landscape of Brittany ... Although different formats, I chose not to resize the pair of large dark oak frames in which I made them go up. This first, on which the signature is the most legible, shows us a Breton village corner to which descends a gentle slope herbue, in an extraordinary palette of blue, green and purple ...
