TEFILLINE BAG in the form of shield. Velvet of red silk embroidered with gold threads forming a scrollwork decoration. Embroidered on one side of the name of God and on the other side an inscription in Hebrew. Below, the initials of the owner: DJB. Ottoman style work, most likely 19th century. Height: 28 cm - Width: 21 cm. Good condition, some wear on the surface, visible on our photos. Rare object, small museum item. definition of the Museum of Judaism: Tefillin. phylacteries. Boxes containing verses of the Torah and placing one on the forehead. and the other on the left arm (for the right-handed ones) using belts. Especially to pray the Shema Yisrael in the morning. Tefillin chel yad. case of the hand. It is the cube with passages of the Torah
