Description

Poetic and romantic, this oil on canvas by the Provençal painter Henri Malfroy known as Savigny born in 1895 and died in 1944. The work is in good condition, it is offered in a gilded frame that measures 68 cm by 51 cm and 55 cm by 38 for the canvas alone.

It represents a tartane at sunset, probably on the Etang de Berre, where the artist, worthy son of Charles Malfroy, born in Martigues had his habits.

Painter of landscapes, but especially of seascapes.
Post-impressionist.

Born on January 15, 1895 in Martigues (Bouches-du-Rhône). Died in 1942.

He did his apprenticeship at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris with his father Charles

Malfroy, with whom he is often confused.

He exhibited regularly in Paris, at the Salon des Artistes Français and the Salon des Indépendants until 1934.

Adopting a technique close to impressionism, he painted the coasts and ports of the Bouches-du-Rhône and Var, but also landscapes of Paris and the banks of the Seine.

Settled in Martigues, he broadened his touch, brightened his compositions, getting closer to Provençal landscapers, such as Ziem.
