Golden brass tray decorated in its center with a stapled pattern on the plate representing a Gallic rooster holding in its claws the globe marked with the inscription "FRANCE" and placed on a bundle of four flags bearing the inscription "FREEDOM ORDER PUBLIC ". Skin lining on the back of the present tray. Full of his buttons. Beautiful state of conservation and use, in its own juice. Shipping included for France.
