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Benjamin Franklin, born on January 17, 1706 in Boston, died on April 17, 1790 in Philadelphia. He was a printer, publisher (editor), writer, naturalist, and an inventor of the American political system. He participated in the writing (editorial staff) of the Declaration of Independence of the United States, of which he is one of the signatories, what makes of him the one of the founders of the United States. During the American Revolution, he negotiated in France as long as a diplomat not only the alliance with the French people, but also the Treaty of Paris. Delegated to the Convention of Philadelphia, he participated in the elaboration of the Constitution of the United States. Benjamin Franklin's life is largely characterized by the will to help the community. The foundation of the first fire department in Philadelphia, the first lending library of States
