Copper engraving drawn by JB Lallemand(1716-1803) with in the foreground shepherds and herd of cows a little higher the ruins of the Roman theater (was classified in the heritage in 1991) and above a part of the city of Autun with St LadreSt. Lazare Cathedral built in 1120 and currently classified National Heritage.Gravure made around 1780 with privileges of the King and references to birds in the margin, drawn from nature by JB LALLEMAND (1716-1803) and engraved on copper by Maillet .This painter excelled in marine landscape paintings and history (the taking of the Bastille) made various engravings of the cities of Burgundy (Autun - Chalon - Cluny - Macon ...)
