Rare and spectacular round metal soup tureen doubled of the Charles X period. It is adorned with a large seed of capture as well as a palmettes edge and beautiful handles nicely worked. Piece attributed to the orfe Charles Balaine specialized in the work of the doubled money. Process of rolling a copper foil against two sheets of silver. Slight traces of wear Leaving the copper on top of the lid Note two tiny tiny holes in the size of a pin in the bottom of the tureen.
