This watch is in good condition. Chain movement and on-demand ringing work. It will certainly be revised. She is stamped on the bail. We do not have the original key. The gold hands are original. The on-demand buzzer works by pressing the bail. A note: the brass bell is broken, some small dents and depressions, wear time, see photos.
