René Le Forestier, born in Pontivy in 1903, died in Concarneau in 1972, is a French painter who lived in Concarneau and painted especially Brittany. Originally trained as a hairdresser, René Le Forestier was a pupil of Arthur Midy and settled in Concarneau 14, place Saint-Guénolé where he held an art gallery, in the heart of the
