Description

Portrait of a young woman wearing chrysanthemums in her hair (allegory of Spring?) SCHREIBER Charles Baptiste (1847-1902) Known for his works on the religious and ecclesiastical world, he is also responsible for animated scenes, portraits of young girls He also studied Orientalist scenes, mainly in Algeria (passage Bonnet in Algiers). He studied in Leon Bonnat and Brandon's studios, then began at the Salon of 1868, where he obtained an honorable mention in 1901. The Reims retains him "young Italian knitting", probably from 1876. piece affixed to the back of the canvas, at the lower left hair. frame with the 19C gold leaf.
