Peter the Hermit harangues the Crusaders in 1095 Peter the Hermit, a native of the environs of Amiens, is the principal preacher of the first crusade. An eloquent speaker, he leads the popular elements to the Holy Land in 1096, but most will die before reaching their goal. In 1099, he participated in the siege of Jerusalem by organizing processions around the city and haranguing the Crusaders. Peter the Hermit is the main preacher of the first crusade. In 1095, he would have made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem from which he would have returned with a letter from God ordering the Christians to come to the aid of their co-religionists in the East. He would then have met the pope, before the Council of Clermont, and began to preach the pilgrimage to the Holy Places. He is an eloquent and inspiring
