Description

Small walnut Neo-Renaissance style two-tiered sideboard opening with two door leaves in the lower part and one door leaf in the upper part, two drawers in the middle. The whole ensemble stands on four legs with the front set-off and decorated with swirls and masks.

A rich carved molding adorned with caning patterns has carved set-off side uprights decorated with masks, garlands and acanthus leaves.

The two drop leaves opening on a shelf while the upper drawers can be opened with a winged lion forming handle.

The upper part, shallowing, is flanked by shelves on each side on standing on a chimaera and a swirls background.

Decorative register inherited of the Renaissance -Henri II period, such as grotesques, swirls,
