The catch of the flower pot represents elephant
heads. Good condition (small accident to the

Faiencier d'Art, Edouard GILLES trained as a
painter on porcelain. He was head of workshop at
Collinot before settling in 1868 in Paris. His
studio was located at 2 Boulevard Jourdan, he
produced artistic faience as early as the 1880s.
