Paul-Emile Lecomte (1877-1950) View of village, Signed lower right watercolor on paper transferred on strong paper 38 x 55 cm In good condition, trace of a horizontal crease perceptible in the top Paul Emile Lecomte (1877- 1950). Painter of watercolors and oil paintings, etcher, and engraver. He was the pupil of Fernand Cormon and of his uncle Paul Lecomte. He became Official Painter of the French Navy in 1921. He painted at the beginning of his career in the same style as his famous uncle, Paul Lecomte (1842-1920) . His first works are often attributed falsely to him as their signature can be confounded. But he soon developed his own style, of which this work is a very good example.
