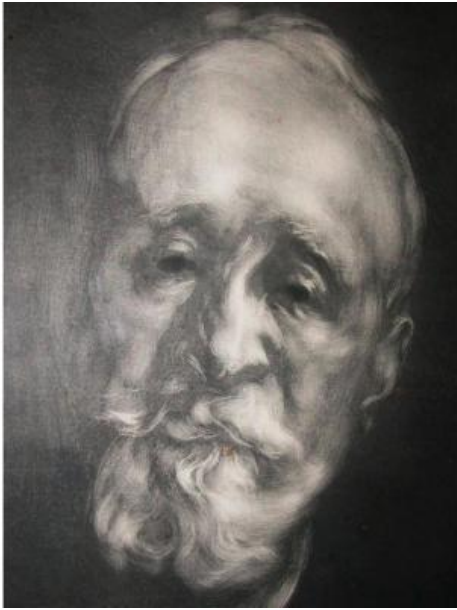




Portrait Of Puvis De Chavannes Signed By Pencil From The Hand Of Eugène Carrière
