The bigourdan painter Lucien Jules Gros (1896-1942) is a perfect example: namesake of Lucien Alphonse (1845-1913), and not being in the databases, his works are systematically given to his eldest, who, to be nice, has never, to my knowledge, painted the Pyrenees that ours loved so much.

Often treated with oil in a key perpendicular to the support, as well in small formats as in large panoramic that his profession of painter decorator has placed in hotels and casinos.
