## Description

Allegory of "the vineyard" by Henryk KOSSOWSKI (1855-1921). We could also see an allegory of autumn by picking grapes maturing in this season. The sculptor put in place of the vine principal a young woman with long flowing hair whose slender figure and generous forms are highlighted by a transparent dress agitated by the wind. Her movement opposes the rigidity of the secondary branch of the vine growing up along the girl up to make him a crown of grapes around the head. Leaves and bunches at maturity, close to the harvest, form a rising garland. A cluster holding the arm raised above the head of the girl is exposed to all as the sign of the success of the harvest .The support of the sculpture is a green onyx pendulum with gilded bronze ornaments .The mechanism is a movement of VINCENTI
