Description

Rare convenient called sarcophagus opening with three drawers on three rows, on arched feet with belt scalloped. Model in violet wood veneer * in wood of thread and end, applied in crimping and in sheet. This violet wood or violet wood is the Dalbergia Cearensis which comes from Brazil. Rich and important ornamentation of bronzes gilded with mercury of origin of which: falls in mask of woman with feathers, entries of locks, drooping handles with the cornucopias, feet back in foliage of acanthus, apron carved of acanthes and hooves very finely chiseled on the front. the drawers separated by a brass groove. Marble top of Belgian origin, molded with a beak of corbin and surmounted by a cavet. Frame and drawer fronts are spruce fir, the interior of the drawers are walnut. Rare Tomb Commode, called
