Oil on canvas called cardboard from the Aubusson factory. Scene of medieval life in an orchard, where a young lady accompanied by her preceptor and a maid indulge in the joys of picking seasonal fruits. True matrix of tapestry scale 1 tapestry cardboard had several vocations. Initially, the cardboard allowed the development and customization of a decor by moving the silhouettes of the characters and dominant objects to a decor set according to the size of the tapestry to make it unique. In a second time the cardboard allowed the master straighteners to match the colors of the wool and silk to transpose the pictorial work and to make a tapestry. The master painters real painters executed gigantic works according to the themes and the taste of the moment influenced by prestigious masters in
