Vigilance can be identified by the cock standing at his feet and symbolizing attention. Faith, of course, is more easily identifiable with the cross it holds.

Hubert-François Bourguignon d'Anville, dit Gravelot (March 26, 1699 - April 19, 1773) is an illustrator, engraver, illustrator and painter who had some success in London at the beginning of the eighteenth century and gave it the expression " French taste ".
