Clock in the Zouave of North Africa Moroccan, Algerian, Tunisian leaning on his rifle in his outfit with his backpack. During the campaigns of Napoleon III, the Zouaves are distinguished on many occasions. During the Crimean War (1853-1856), which is the 1st campaign where the Zouaves intervene outside Algeria, at the Battle of Alma, the 3rd regiment wins against the Russians. It is as a tribute to this decisive victory for the end of the war that the Zouave du Pont de l'ALMA was made on the Seine in Paris. At the same period as a reward Napoleon III created a Zouave regiment for its imperial guard. The theme of this clock was probably influenced by these events.
