Around 1860 Europe Beautiful dress with crinoline walk or indoor printed stamen bayadère dating from the Second Empire. Very fine roll impression on wool of Alsatian or English origin (?). Large cherry red satin bands bordered with emerald green emerald in the military spirit very popular at that time. Opening on the front by fasteners and buttons covered with black velvet. Waistline in trimmings and tassels in the same. Chintze chamois cotton lining. Very good state of conservation and color. Dimensions: shoulders 48 cm, sleeves 44 cm, bust 36 cm, skirt height 102 cm, circumference 300 cm. Pluses: This dress "frock" is probably also interior thanks to its rather spectacular style! Probably American English or European, it comes from a prestigious collection ... in a print on wool potentially
