A few years after being a member of the Academy of Copenhagen, he was approved at the Royal Academy of Painting and Sculpture in 1789, then became engraver of the King. He has several

Jan Baptisye Weenix was born in Amsterdam in 1621 and died in Haarzullens between 1659 and 1661, is a Dutch painter (United Provinces) of the golden century. He realized imaginary landscapes as well as seascapes, views of water features, portraits, representations of animals and still lifes. The painting that served for the execution of this engraving entitled 'The party of pleasure' is on display in Paris at the Petit Palais, the Paris Museum of Fine Arts
