Portrait of Georg Petel, sculptor on ivory, major figure of the Mannerist sculpture in the service of the counter reformation. Portrait painted around 1628, powerful, intimate style, poses a melancholy grace. Our portrait of a great sobriety conceived with soft curves. The blue night coat highlighting the carnation of the model. Copy of the early eighteenth century, around 1720, very high quality, faithful execution of the style of Van Dyck. It is also close to the "man with the glove" of Titian, visible in the Louvre Museum In
