Description

Adorable white marble bust after Houdon: the bust of Louise Brongniart dating from the nineteenth century.

It is therefore the white marble bust of Louise Brongniart (1772-1845), the daughter of the architect of the Palais de la Bourse in Paris. this bust was commissioned to Jean-Antoine Houdon (1741-1828) and is now preserved in the Louvre Museum.

Here is a copy in direct size of the late nineteenth century executed after Houdon and signed on the back.

He is resting on a pedestal. the whole is very high quality and the sculptor has made the vivacity and beauty of the girl's face.

a very beautiful marble of Carrara was chosen, with a very fine grain.
