Curious cabinet forming oak writing desk, Norman work of the region of Le Havre. Constituted in the upper part of a row of three drawers, a writing desk concealing 6 small drawers, a door cut, Louis XIV inside and outside, sides has fretted cross, ending foot back. Quality furniture. According to the family tradition, this piece of furniture would have served the accountant of a shipowner and was used to point the goods in the storage rooms. 18th century.
