This sculpture signed by the artist Eugène L'Hoest is of a good quality in the way the artist treated the modeling.

Eugène L'Hoest is a French artist, having studied art in Angers then worked in the workshops of several artists in Paris in 1891. In 1893, he presents for the first time a work at the Salon of French Artists, and he participated in the Universal Exhibition of 1900.In 1906; he gets a scholarship that will allow him to travel to Italy and North Africa.
